

Skip Polowy Corvettes of Buffalo

Betty Skelton, the former acrobatic pilot and Corvette test driver who was known as the "fastest woman on Earth" died Wednesday August 31,2011 at the age of 85. For her contributions to Corvette which included roles as a test driver, car show technical narrator and one of the founders of Corvette News (which later became Corvette Quarterly), Betty was inducted into the Corvette Hall of Fame in 2001. Betty was born in Pensacola, Florida and made her first solo flight at the age of 12. By 18, she held a commercial pilots license and was a certified flight instructor. Her father organized an amateur air show in 1945 and Betty was asked to do some basic stunts. Having mastered some aerobatic maneuvers, Betty became a professional aerobatic pilot and performed at air shows across the country. Betty's most impressive stunt during this time was cutting a ribbon strung between two poles with her propeller while flying upside down 10 feet off the ground. Skelton held the title for the US Female Aerobatics Championship from 1948-1950. In 1949 she set the world light-plane altitude record of 25,763 in a Piper Cub and two years later broke her own record with a flight of 29,050 feet. In 1953 after retiring from aerobatic flying, Betty was piloting charter flights when she met NASCAR's Bill France Sr. Bill invited Betty to Daytona Beach in 1954 where she drove the Pace Car. She then took a Dodge sedan to 105.88 mph on the beach, setting a stock car speed record for women. It was in 1956 that she joined Campbell-Ewald, the advertising partner of General Motors. She became the first woman technical narrator at the major auto shows where she would talk about the cars and demonstrate their features. Zora Arkus-Duntov put her to work as a test driver where she set numerous speed records with Corvettes. In 1957, Harley Earl and Bill Mitchell designed a special translucent gold Corvette which Betty drove to Daytona in 1957 to serve as the NASCAR pace car. It was also during this time that Betty Skelton became the official spokeswoman for Chevrolet. Her career in advertising was moving just a quickly. While at Campbell-Ewald, Skelton helped launch the internal magazine called Corvette News which later became known as Corvette Quarterly. She became VP of Campbell-Ewald's Women's Market and Advertising departing in 1969 and retired in 1976 after 20 years in advertising. Skelton was the first woman to drive an Indy car and she repeatedly set records for speed and acceleration at Daytona Beach and on the Bonneville Salt Flats of Utah. In 1956, she broke a transcontinental speed record, driving from New York to Los Angeles, covering 2,913 miles in 56 hours, 58 minutes. In 2001, Betty Skelton was inducted in the National Corvette Museum's Corvette Hall of Fame for all her contributions to Corvette. She is also a member of the National Aviation Hall of Fame as well as the Motorsports Hall of Fame.


Note from John: When ordering aftermarket wheels for the C8, make sure that the offsets are correct. In Florida, many C8 owners have gotten specialty wheels and removed the stock ones. Sometimes wheels that fit become a real problem if the offset differs from Chevrolet specs.

Also: In an update sent out to Chevrolet dealers today, General Motors announced it would be extending the 1st service visit time for 2020 to 2022 Corvettes from the standard 12 months of ownership to 36 months. According to the memo, the extension was made to be "more suitable for the driving habits experienced with Corvette owners" which is another way of saying that Corvette owners don't put a lot of miles on their cars. We're not sure what has prompted this as GM has the oil life monitor programmed to go off just under one year so you have to do that regardless. We're thinking it has to do with the transmission filter that is required to be changed at 7500 miles but is included in the 1st service visit. Perhaps GM wants to condition C8 drivers now to wait until the full 7500 miles before triggering the free service visit as they were probably replacing the majority of those filters at well under 7500 miles. 

We are hearing a lot about Z06 lately, so here's some info on an earlier one you may not have known. It's worth watching: We also know that many of you may be new to the Corvette brand, and in that case, it's time for a history lesson on the King of the Hill Corvette – the C4 ZR-1. Hagerty's Jason Cammisa offers up these revelations about the C4 ZR-1 (with a Lotus designed LT-5) and he shares many details and stories behind the car that only the die-hards would know about, including its apparent ability to defeat police radar guns back in the day due to this "one weird trick."

It's fair to say that the most exotic engine to ever reside beneath the hood of a production Corvette was the 1990-'95 5.7-liter LT5—engineered by GM and Lotus, then machined and assembled by Mercury Marine's MerCruiser division in Stillwater, Oklahoma. The engine was initially rated at 375 hp and 370 lb-ft of torque, but a revised LT5 broke cover in 1993. Packing four-bolt main caps, improved heads, new pistons, revised cam timing, and new exhaust manifolds, that engine checked in at a gutsy 405 hp and 385 lb-ft of torque. Many of the LT5's innovations are common now, but they were revolutionary in the 1990s.



The black-tie formal, scrapped this year because of the Covid-19 pandemic, will be held Jan. 15 in the Seneca Niagara Casino in the Falls, the medical center announced. The event usually draws a sellout crowd of about 900. The 2020 Premier raised about \$275,000 for the hospital.

Co-chairs of the 2022 event include Buffalo Common Council member Darius Pridgen and his son, Pastor Craig Pridgen, and Dr. Ravinder K. Devgun, Memorial's chief of anesthesiology, and his wife, Sukhmender S. Saran.

Bajwa, Memorial's chief of infectious diseases, led the hospital's response to the pandemic.

Salvatore, owner of Russell's Steaks, Chops & More, has donated millions of dollars to area hospitals, including a major gift to renovate Memorial's welcome center in 2019.


