PRESIDENT BOB SPEAKS:








PROSPECTIVE MEMBER – LEON COLUCCI

When I drove my best friend from Cape Vincent, N.Y. to get his latest purchase, a 2019 Orange convertible in Pennsylvania (top left photo) I knew I might have to buy another Corvette. Sixty-years ago he drove me to Palmyra (now Van Bortel Chevrolet) to get my new Silver 1969 w/Close-Ratio 4-Speed. It was my third Corvette. After seeing his beautiful rag-top - my online search intensified. I found a 2007 'little-red' rag-top in Venice, California; but due to the height of Covid-19, last year, my young cousin brought me back to reality, convincing me to skip that purchase (with my planned 'slow-ride' on Route-66 back East).

My research continued, I decided I wanted a convertible 'Rag-Top' one with 'Paddle-Shift' and with the newer LS-3, 400+ Horsepower Engine. I found my 10th Corvette on eBay in Miami. The price was right; but it had a 'Rebuilt Title'. Luckily, I remembered my friend Bob who lived in South Florida. He could check it out, and was able to take a drive with the owner; Bob used his cell to give me a live-feed to see this 2013 Red Rag Top. He said: "Leon: this car is very nice, only a bit over 50,000 miles, drives & stops straight, no leaks and looks very good". Well with that I flew to Miami; was pleasantly surprised. FINALLY IN 2004 MY WIFE, KAREN, FOR OUR 25TH WEDDING ANNIVERSARY SURPRISED ME WITH A 1987 RED CONVERTIBLE CORVETTE. GETTING BEHIND THE WHEEL FOR THE FIRST TIME WAS EXCITING, DRIVING IT AROUND WAS FABULOUS. IT WAS A DREAM TURNED INTO A REALITY. NOW THE BACK STORY, I HAD ONE OF THE FIRST FIAT X 1/9'S IN BUFFALO. I HAD "ANSA" EXHAUST INSTALLED, SOUNDED GREAT AND LOOKED LIKE A MINI "PANTERA". ALTHOUGH A FOUR CYCLINDER, THE HANDLING WAS SUPERB. MY THOUGHTS WERE WHEN, IF EVER WOULD THE DREAM OF A MID-ENGINE CORVETTE BE REALIZED. NOW TO THE PRESENT, THE C8 – THE DREAM HAS ARRIVED. BUT HOW TO EXPERIENCE IT WHEN TRYING TO GET ONE IS DIFFICULT BUT NOT QUITE IMPOSSIBLE. AAAAA, CHECK OUT THE NATIONAL CORVETTE MUSEUM AND MOTORSPORTS PARK. IT'S INCREDIBLE, THEY ACTUALLY HAVE A C8 EXPERIENCE, COMPLETE WITH A HANDS ON, SECOND PLACE CORVETTE RACING TEAM INSTRUCTOR – ANDY PILGRIM. ANDY'S PHILOSOPHY IN DESIGNING THIS EXPERIENCE IS TO DEVELOP NEW DRIVING SKILLS ON THE TRACK AND ON THE STREET. HIS MOTTO, "SAFETY FIRST". I WAS PART OF A CLASS OF 14 PARTICIPANTS, TRAVELING FROM CALIFORNIA, MASSACHUSETTS, ARIZONA, AND GEORGIA. EACH OF US WAS ASSIGNED A MOTORSPORTS PARK C8 EQUIPPED WITH Z51 PACKAGE. STARTING WITH A 45 MINUTE BRIEFING ON TIMED "AUTOCROSS" DRILLS, THEN PROCEEDING TO THE PADDOCK WHERE EACH ONE OF THE 14 STUDENTS DROVE TWO TIMES, WITH ANDY CRITQUING AFTER EACH LAP. ONE PARTICIPANT AT A TIME, WE EACH DROVE TWO LAPS PER SET AND WE DID THREE SETS.

AFTERWARDS WE RETURNED FOR INSTRUCTIONS ON TRACK SAFETY AND PROCEDURES. THIS IS A "LEAD/FOLLOW" SESSION, ONE INSTRUCTOR FOLLOWED BY TWO DRIVERS. WE WOULD KEEP A 3-4 CAR SEPARATION AND FOLLOW OUR INSTRUCTOR FOR SIX LAPS AND THEN A CRITIQUE BY ANDY. THIS SESSION CONSISTED OF 3 SETS OF 6 LAPS EACH, AFTER EACH SET THE DRIVERS WOULD SWITCH POSITIONS. EACH DRIVER HAD A "SD" CARD ASSIGNED TO THEM, WHICH IS REALLY NEAT. IT HAS BECOME A FAVORITE ON OUR BIG SCREEN TV AT HOME.

IF YOU'RE WONDERING ABOUT THE EXPERIENCE... I AM SO "PUMPED" AND "SUPER" ENTHUSED! THE C8 IS **PHENOMINAL**. IN OUR CLASS SESSIONS THE QUESTION CAME UP ABOUT PADDLE SHIFTING. ANDY'S RESPONSED, "WHICH IS CHEAPER TO REPAIR/REPLACE TIRES AND BRAKES OR TRANSMISSIONS?" WE COULD USE THE PADDLES IF WE CHOOSE TO, BUT HIS PREFERENCE WAS TO USE "TRACK" MODE AND LET THE COMPUTER DO THE SHIFTING WHETHER UP OR DOWN. THE C8 IS INCREDIBLE, UNBELIEVEABLE, AND FANTASTIC. WITH THE TRACTION CONTROL AND ANTI-SKID AND OF COURSE SOME EXCELLENT POINTERS FROM ANDY, ONE CAN TRULY ENJOY THEIR C8 EITHER ON THE TRACK OR THE STREET. THE C8 IS COMFORTABLE WHEREVER YOUR TRAVELS TAKE YOU. ENJOY AND "FASTEN YOUR SEATBELTS" YOU'RE IN FOR AN EXHILARATING EXPERINCE.


Subject: Ireland (Editor: no waiting for the National Geographic, as we have the photos here)






